Everything you ever wanted to know about EFT!

How does EFT work?

Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT), a.k.a. Easy Fitness Ticket, is an automatic deduction by Jazzercise, Inc. from your checking account. It's fast, easy and has the Jazzercise seal of security and assurance.

When is money deducted?

Funds transfer on the first of the month. The current EFT is \$45 per month (subject to change). EFT students receive our lowest price because they have expressed their commitment to our classes.



How many classes can I attend?

EFT is a monthly pass that gives you **unlimited classes** at all www.JazzWithMe.com locations.

Do I really save money with EFT?

EFT students with 6-month commitment enjoy an annual savings of up to \$170.00 – a value of more than 3 months FREE Jazzercise!



What if I register mid-month?

A prorated EFT payment will process on the first of the month. Our friendly Customer Service Representatives can tell you the exact amount.

Is there a minimum enrollment period?

If you sign up for 6 months, the \$50 joining fee is waived – it's our way of saying thank you for your commitment to your health and our Jazzercise classes. Or you can choose our EFT month-to-month option. Even with the \$50 joining fee, you still save \$120 a year!

Suppose I have to cancel my enrollment?

You may cancel with written notice in class or by e-mail by the 15th of the month prior. Early cancellation fees (\$50) will apply for those in the 6-month program, and the agreement will automatically convert to month-to-month until the customer cancellation request is received.

If I cancel then re-enroll later, will I get the same rate?

Re-enrollments are processed at the current EFT rate.



Is there a charge to re-enroll?

Students not enrolled for 2 months or longer are assessed the current joining fee.

Can I put EFT on hold if I go on vacation or have an injury?

EFT members enjoy a low annual rate, earning more than 3 months of unlimited JazzWithMe.com classes. This comes in handy for those times when you miss a class.



What happens if I change checking accounts?

Simply contact a Customer Service Representative for an EFT Amendment form. Need help filling it out? Just ask.
